TEMPERATURE

- High Rectal Temperature (Above 104°F)
- Feels Very Hot To The Touch



PHYSICAL SIGNS

- Excessive Sweating
- Panting - Labored Breathing
- Nostril Flaring
- Muscle Spasms
- Abnormal Heart Rate



PERFORMANCE

- Lethargy - Slow Reaction to Environment
- Slow Recovery After Exercise
- Decreased Performance



BEHAVIOR

- Decreased Appetite
- Decreased Thirst
- Decreased Urination (Dark Urine)
